## ***Fire Island Pines Property Owners Association***

FIPPOA was incorporated in 1953 to assume responsibility for the community's property, and through the years the association's role has expanded to become the recognized local government representing the interests of Fire Island Pines with federal, state, Suffolk County and Town of Brookhaven officials and agencies. With more than 500 members, FIPPOA is led by elected Officers and a Board of Directors who oversee the operations of the community and help protect the fragile ecosystem of a barrier island. Those operations include the Pines Harbor and Marina, which the association owns and from which it derives a substantial portion of its income. Whyte Hall, the new community center, is the other principal asset, playing a significant role in the many services FIPPOA provides to residents and visitors.

## ***Post Office***

The Spring Hours are from 11:45am to 1:30pm on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. Beginning May 24, the hours are from 11am to 1pm on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

For access to PO Boxes, the lobby is open daily from 10am to 4pm.

The Post Office offers most services, with the exception of Money Orders, Passports, and Home Delivery. There is no home delivery. Mail without PO Box Numbers will be returned. Mail must say Fire Island Pines, if addressed to Sayville it will be returned. The proper form is:

## ***Waste Collection/Recycling***

Residential Collection is Monday and Thursday; Recycling Collection takes place on Wednesday, April through September. Each residence is limited to three cans of construction debris each week. All waste, including yard debris and bulk items, are collected at the front of each residence. Glass, Metal, and Plastic may be commingled and newspapers and corrugated containers must be bundled.

### **DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING ON FIRE ISLAND BLVD. DUMPING IS ILLEGAL.**

Please make sure that all garbage is in covered cans so that the deer, rodents, and other animals are prevented from breaking them open.

Fire Island Pines is a “green community”. Please use the containers in the harbor and the beach entrances accordingly.

## ***Noise and Lights***

Unreasonable noise is against the law. Daytime hours are considered to be 7am to 10pm. Nighttime hours are considered to be 10pm to 7am. Construction noise is exempt from the ordinance, but is limited to the hours of 7am to 6pm on weekdays. Spotlights that cross property lines are illegal.
